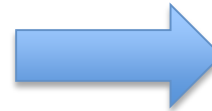


STRATEGIC REFRESH

- Collaboration is a guiding principle
- Structure for implementation:
 - Steering group: MBIE, MOH, HRC, DHBs, Callaghan, Universities NZ
 - Working group: MBIE, MOH, HRC and Callaghan
 - External Advisory group: national and international experts
 - Theme specific groups: Development group (Action 1)

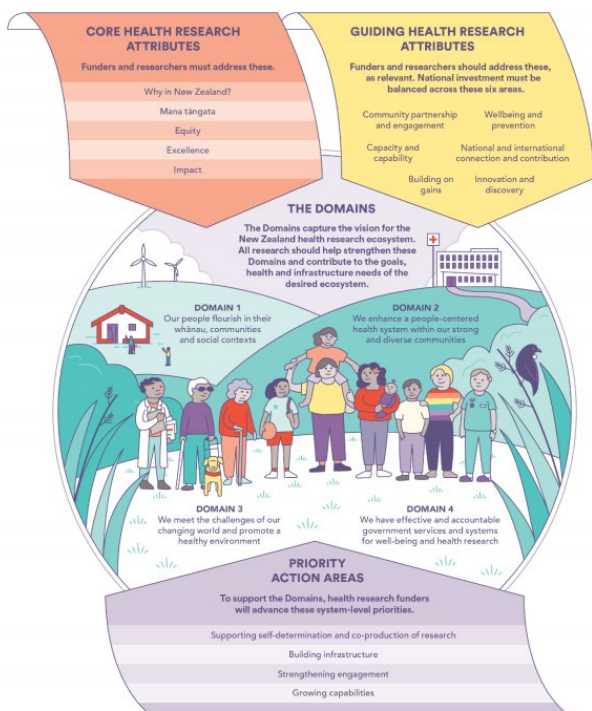

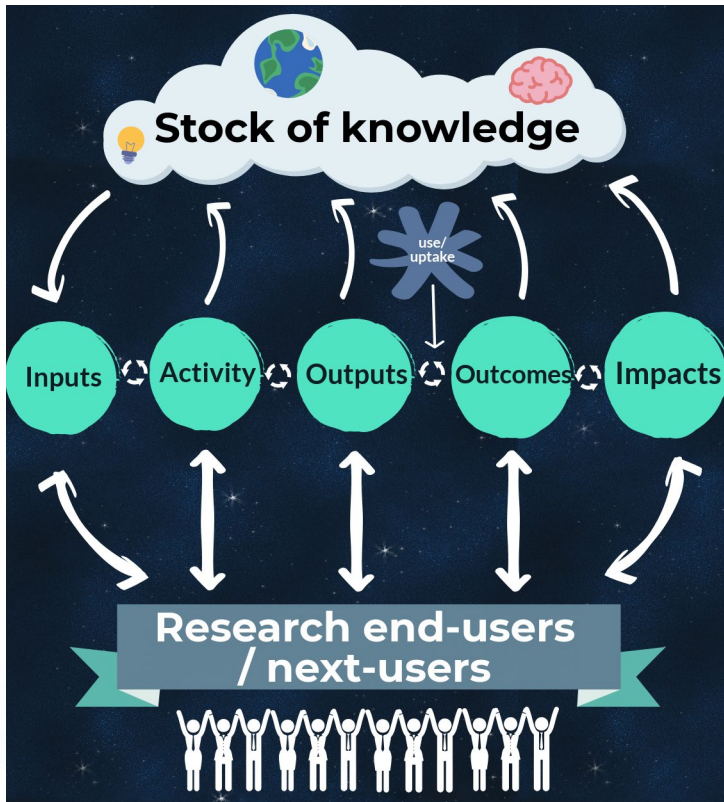
- Action 1: final consultation open
- System level approach for all health research funders
- Clinical trials in Domain 2
- Actions 2-4: ongoing/in development
- ‘Develop & sustain a strong health research workforce’

INVESTMENT

- Investing in clinical research:
 - 20% of budget invested in clinical research (AFR)
 - Flexible funding models for trials
- Building the clinical trial workforce:
 - Career development awards aligned with career stage
 - 60% of contracts with clinician investigator (AFR)
- Other mechanisms
 - Partnership funding and IRO investment
- HRC Investment Plan
